REMOVAL AND COLLECTION OF WASTE

Q&A and Practical Module

1. Put out warning signs.



2. Ensure that correct PPE is worn. – follow the **Risk Assessment**.



3. **NEVER PRESS DOWN WASTE WITH YOUR HANDS.**

4. Always follow manual handling training whilst moving waste.

5. **Removing and collecting waste.**

- Assemble appropriate equipment and place warning signs where applicable. - *why is it important to assemble equipment? – why do you need to place out warning signs?*
- Ash tray waste should always be emptied into a metal container for disposal. General waste should be emptied into a clear sack. - *why would you always empty an ashtray into a metal container? – what is the importance of using clear sacks?*
- Whenever possible ensure that recycled waste is kept separate to general waste and transported to the correct bin for segregation. i.e. Card, General Glass & Card should always be separated where practical. - *can you identify the different waste streams?*
- **Never** overfill waste sacks. – *why would you not overfill sacks? – what can happen if you do?*

- Clean up and residue waste from the surrounding area. - **which procedure would you follow if this needed to be done?**
- Plan the route for collection of waste as you travel. - **can you explain the manual handling procedure?**
- Always work methodically around each area, collecting all waste as you go. - **what are the benefits of working methodically? – what are the pitfalls?**
- All bins to be then wiped down to remove any spillages and stains.
- All waste to be transported to designated waste bin areas. – **how do you identify which waste goes into which bin?**
- Clean equipment and return to store. - **why is it important to clean equipment and return to the relevant store?**
