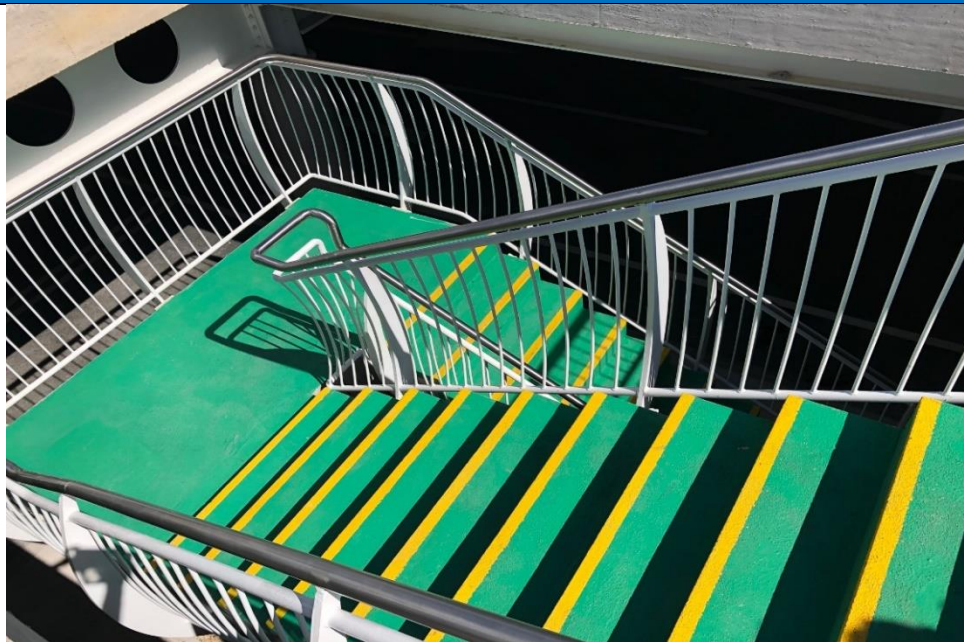

TASK 2 CLEANING STAIRCASES & STEPS

Risk Assessment: Refer to relevant RAMS - folder in office

MSDS Sheets: Refer to COSHH folders located in office & all cleaning cupboards

Equipment Required for task – use relevant colour coded equipment

Safety signage x 2	Duster
Dustpan & Brush	Mop & Bucket
Clean microfibre cloth	Litter picker
Mop & Bucket	

Chemicals required including dosing details

Multi-surface floor cleaner	Jontec 300 = 40ml per litre water
Stainless steel/glass cleaner	Taski Sprint 200 Pur Eco smart dose
Disinfectant	Premiere Screen Virucidal
	500ml of water to 20ml disinfectant
	2.5lt of water to 100ml of disinfectant

Location of Cleaning Task PPE required for task

Staircases in Malls/Car Parks	Gloves
Stairs in service yards	Goggles for dilution
Fire Escape stairs	Mask for dilution

Step by Step cleaning instructions



PLEASE WASH YOUR HANDS BEFORE & AFTER YOUR TASK

- Place safety signage in position at both top and bottom of stairs
- Litter pick the stairs and immediate areas, both upper and lower (including stairwells).
- Dust the handrails, remove dust and cobwebs from railings & ledges/sides
- Sweep the stairs working from top to bottom
- Clean the stainless steel using relevant cleaner and buff using a dry cloth
- Wring out your mop as tightly as possible and damp mop the stairs from top to bottom.
- When task complete remove safety signage only when the area is safe & dry
