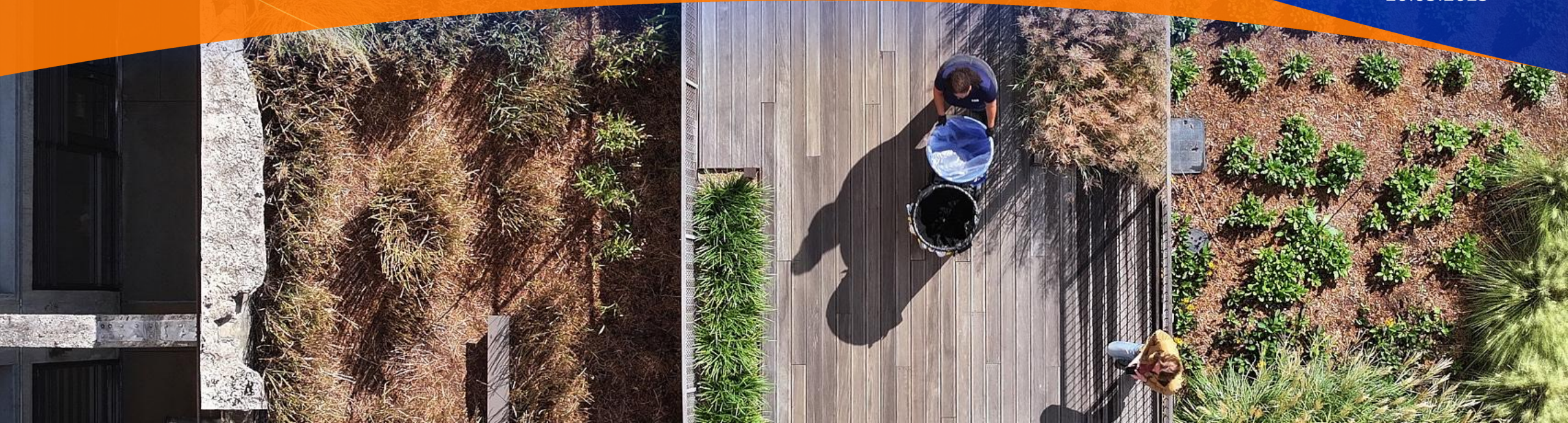

ABM Expectations for Suppliers

Zero tolerance for modern slavery in any form.

Compliance with ABM's Supplier Code of Conduct is mandatory.

Suppliers must actively prevent forced labour and human trafficking.

Participation in audit and training programs is required.

Suppliers must report any concerns or incidents via approved channels.

Ongoing cooperation in demonstrating ethical labor practices.

Understanding Modern Slavery

- Modern slavery affects over 50 million people worldwide.
- Includes forced labour, trafficking, and exploitation.
- It is a global crime that can exist in any country, industry, or supply chain.

Who Is at Risk?

- There is no typical victim – anyone can be affected.
- Risks increase with poverty, lack of education, instability.
 - Men, women, and children can all be victims.

Forms of Modern Slavery

- Examples include forced labour, debt bondage, sexual exploitation, and domestic servitude.
- Victims are controlled through threats, violence, or coercion.
- Can occur in sectors like agriculture, hospitality, and construction.

- Victims may appear malnourished, fearful, or controlled by others.
- They may lack personal documents and freedom of movement.
- Living and working conditions are often poor and restrictive.



How to Respond

- Do not confront the suspected traffickers or alert the victim.
- Report suspicions to ABM or the Modern Slavery Helpline: Link [here](#)
- Ensure safety for yourself and potential victims.

- Modern slavery training is essential to spot and respond to abuse.
 - Suppliers are encouraged to educate their teams.
- ABM supports consistent standards across its supply chain.
